RESERVATION POLICY

The state of Nagaland, located in the North-eastern part of the country, is inhabitated

by the Nagas belonging to the Scheduled Tribe (ST) category. FDurther, Zunheboto district is an

interior, hilly area as such the district is inhabitated mostly by the indegeneous tribal people. In

this regard, the state Government has not come out with a definite reservation policy for

admission of students in the institutions of higher education in the state. However, the

Department of Higher Education, Nagaland, Kohima, has tacitly provided autonnmy to colleges

to make their own policy for category students for admission in colleges.

As per the reservation policy of seats made by the College internally, 91% of seats is

allotted for ST category who are the indegeneous people of this state.

The seats reserved for the differently abled (Divyangjan) are not treated as part of the

statutory reservations but from general/respopective category only.
