Alumni Connect Cell Report 2019 – 2020

The Alumni Connect Cell conducted a survey in 2019 among the Alumni to ascertain its performance, direction of development and future requirement towards the achievement of goals.

Alumni feedback was focused primarily on the below mentioned nine parameters:

- 1. How proud they feel to be a student of this college?
- 2. The learning they had in the college is how much useful in their career?
- 3. The developments in the college in recent years are appreciative to what extent?
- 4. The courses introduced are how much efficient in meeting the contemporary requirements?
- 5. Involvement of alumni in college activities.
- 6. If the alumni feel that they have a role to play in academically strengthening the college further?
- 7. If the alumni feel that they have a role to play in financially strengthening the college?
- 8. Views on the formation of alumni association.
- 9. If the alumni feel that college administration should take initiative to efficiently enroll and strengthen the alumni association.


Recording of feedback data

The Alumni were given feedback forms in which they have to record their responses/satisfaction rate for the above mentioned parameters on the scale of 1 to 5 where 1 is below average and 5 is excellent. Each scale is given 20% weightage and the final results were calculated as cumulative average. The parameters which have average satisfaction rate of 70% or more are considered as positive response.

The alumni were also asked to submit their valuable suggestions, if any, for improvement of the college in different areas.

Result

Based on the alumnicollective responses on the parameters (as mentioned above in Sl.No. 01 to 09) in the feedback form, the following chart represent the satisfaction rate of the alumni on various parameters:



Suggestions by the Alumni

The suggestions from the alumni for improvement of college and its activities include the following main areas:

- 1. Introducing an action committee and action board to attend student grievances.
- 2. Mutual cooperation and respect between the students and authorities to bring healthy, progressive and competitive environment.
- 3. Requesting authorities to bring Honours courses to the college.
- 4. Upgradation of the library so that students can make use of required books and study materials as the students cannot depend largely on internet to make study materials.

Conclusion

From the alumni feedback data chart, the percentage satisfaction rate for parameter 2 (which represent the usefulness of their college learning in their career), parameter 4 (which represent the efficiency of the introduced courses to meet contemporary requirements by the alumni) and parameter 7 (which represent if the alumni feel that they have a role to play in financially strengthening the college) is only 68%, 68% and 64% respectively. Therefore, the college needs to improve on these parameter. The percentage satisfaction rate for all other parameters is recorded 70% or more.

From the Alumni feedback chart and the suggestions submitted by alumni, it is clearly reflecting that the college needs improvements on academics, upgradation of educational resources for students and some other areas as well. Some steps the college may consider to take in this direction are:

- 1. Formation of action committee which may involve both the college authorities and the alumni to take care of student grievances. The same committee can also provide counselling to the students as and when needed.
- 2. Activity based teachings to the students. Other methods may be incorporated in the classroom so as to provide a competitive environment.
- 3. An attempt may be made for the donation of books to the college. This will be very helpful in upgradation of library.
- 4. Activities to bring the students and administration work mutually. College may involve the student and alumni association in its future planning and strategies and can make use of their valuable suggestions.
- 5. Introducing honours courses in the college.
- The Alumnimembers took initiative in beautification of the college by planting flowers in the college campus on 7th March, 2020.
- The Alumni further extended its service by sponsoring the cost of videography during the NAAC peer team visit.
